

## Victorian Bygones

Be a history detective, handle real Victorian artifacts, and find out what life was like for Victorian children and adults. *This session makes an excellent complement to a visit to Preston Manor.*

### Aims of the session

1. To use primary sources, such as objects, artifacts, and ephemera relating to everyday Victorian life, to make discoveries about the past.
2. To make links with people in the past by studying genuine Victorian objects.
3. To find out about the range of materials used in Victorian times.
4. To learn how the Victorians developed unique and imaginative ways to solve particular problems and discover how some of them are still used today.
5. To explore the wider historical context of local Victorian life through understanding travel, trade and technology.
6. To develop an awareness of the similarities and differences between Victorian and modern life.



### History Curriculum Links

- A study overtime tracing how several aspects of national history are reflected in the locality
- A study of an aspect of history dating from a period beyond 1066 that is significant in the locality
